The Book of Esther tells of a woman who accepts the challenge to save her people. She and her uncle, Mordecai, use persistence and supplication to reach this goal.

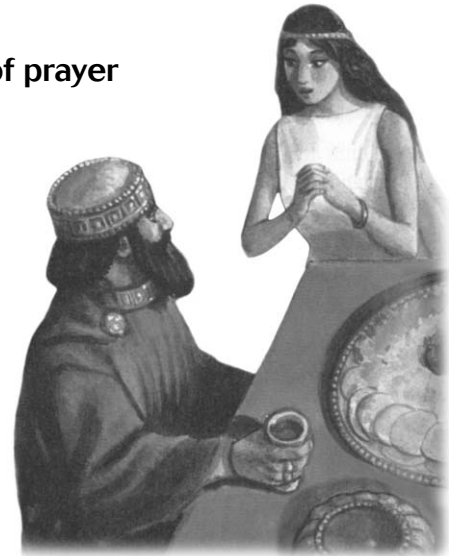
In the examples that follow, decide if they are acts of *persistence* or *supplication*. Write the correct term on the line after each statement
