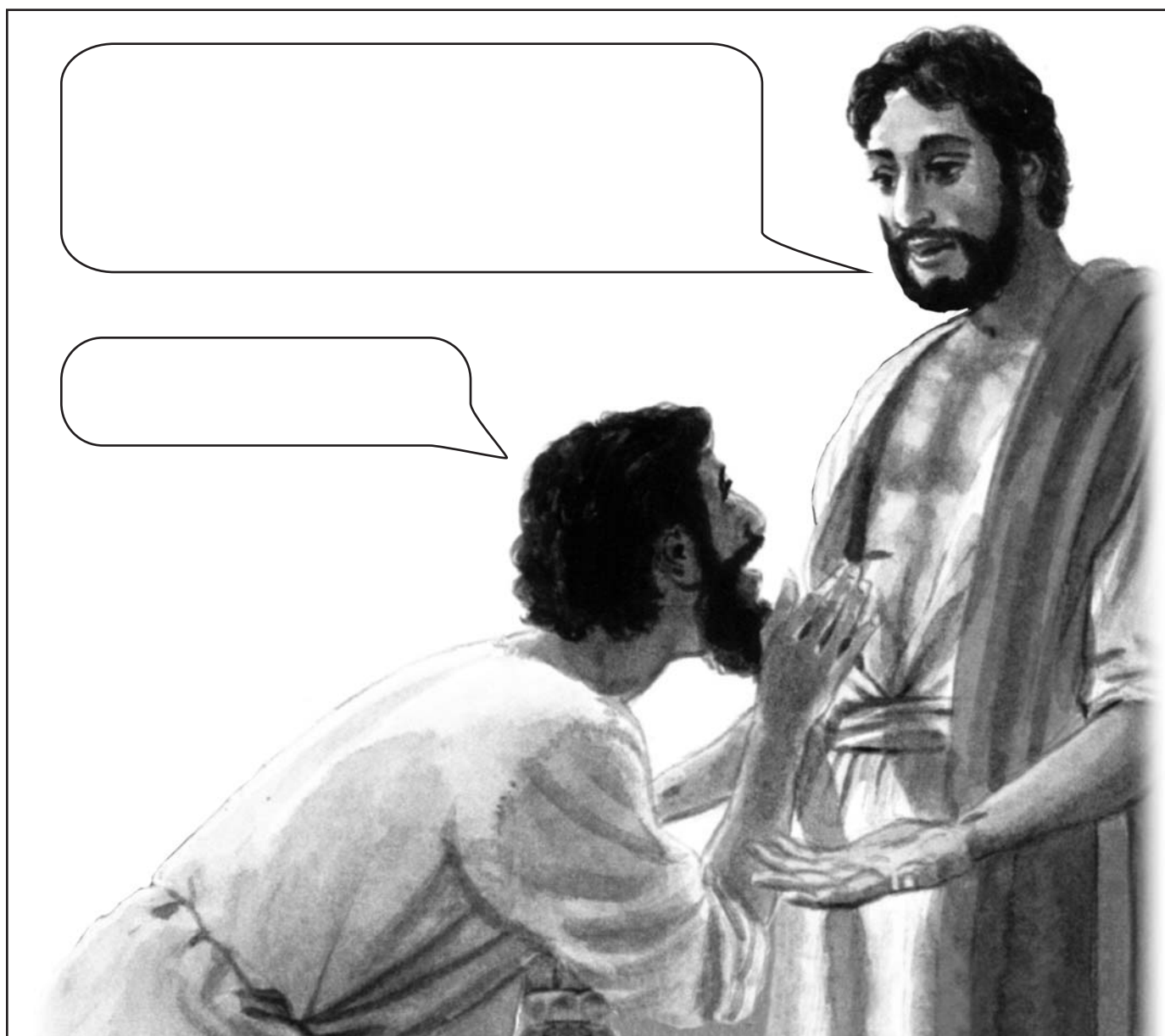


From Doubt to Faith
