

Jesus: Human and Divine

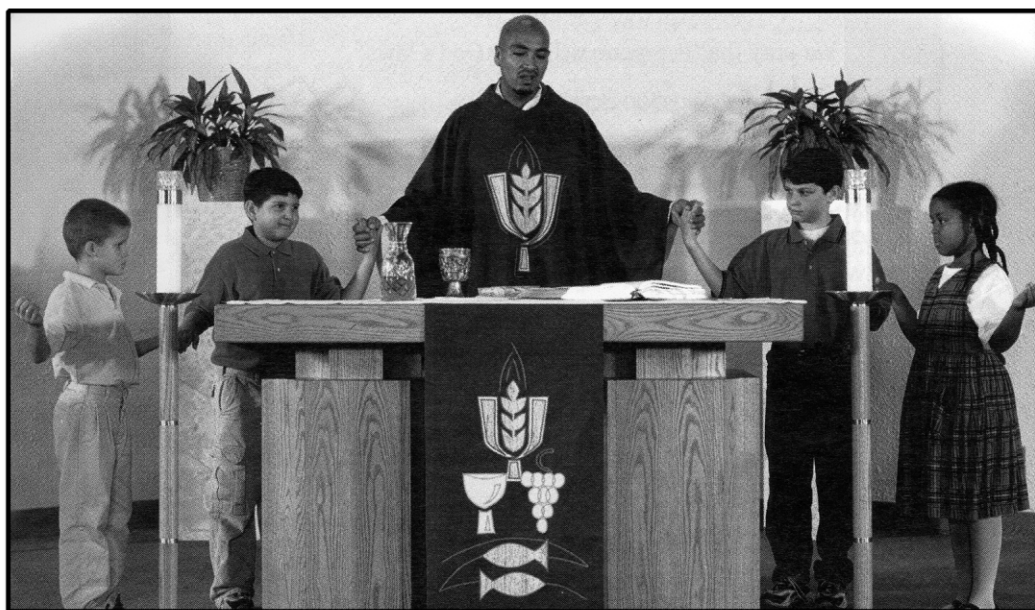
Jesus was born of **Mary** by the power of the **Holy Spirit**. This shows that he is **human**. He is also God's Son. This makes him **divine**.
