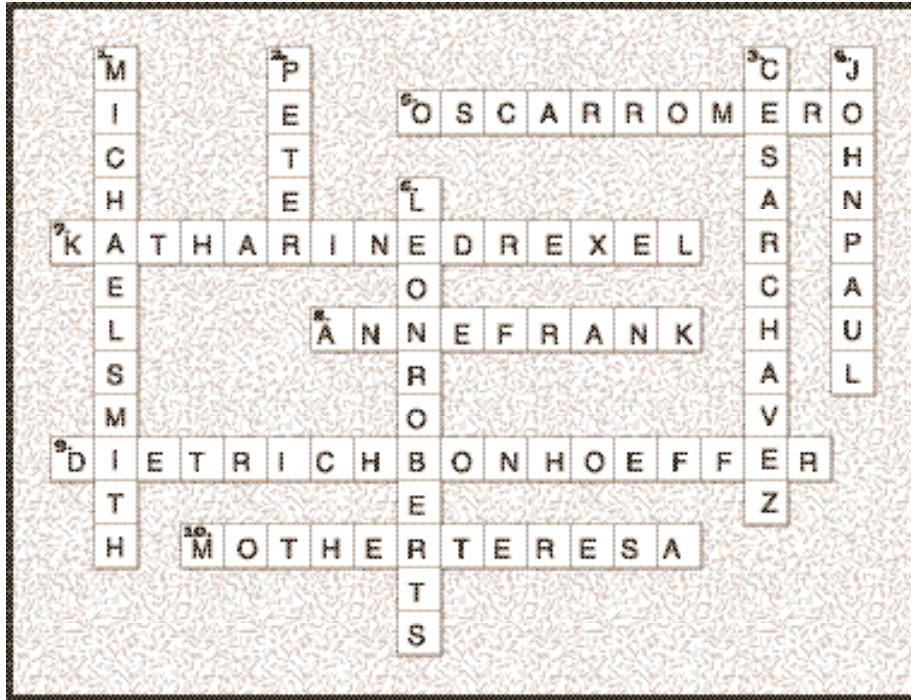


People of the Kingdom
